Help and Advice Line Volunteer

Working with our Outreach Team, you will be taking referrals and providing advice and support over the phone on our help line. The help line currently operates between 9am and 9pm during the week and 11am to 4pm at weekends. We are initially looking for women to work a few hours on week days, this may be extended.

Events Volunteer

You will help set up and run Leeway's events. These will be a range of different activities, from manning stands at exhibitions and conferences to help running fundraising events. These events will take place at different times throughout the year, at various different venues.
