The time you have available can also be discussed.

Fundraising Volunteer

You will be involved with a range of different activities, depending on what you wish to do, from manning stands at exhibitions and conferences, to help running fundraising events, giving talks or thinking of fundraising ideas. These events will take place at different times throughout the year, at various different venues.
